THE POLICY

INTRODUCTION:

NKDA has been receiving applications from different Telecom Service Providers / Infrastructure Providers for permission of installation of Mobile Towers.

There is following provision in the New Town Kolkata Building Rules, 2009 Rule-20(2) note:

"Clearance for microwave system for telecommunication purpose in accordance with such rules or direction issued by or behalf of Govt. of India. No objection certificate from civil aviation authority shall have to be submitted for construction of building."

There are two sets of guidelines-

(a) One issued by **Department of Telecommunication, Government of India** and communicated by letter No. 497(3)-DS(IT)/P/50/2010 dated 17th December, 2014 of Department of Information Technology & Electronics, Government of West Bengal, i.e. –

Advisory Guideline (effective from 01-08-2013) for State Governments for Issue of clearance for installation of Mobile Towers which deals with documents need to be submitted by Telecom Service Providers / Infrastructure providers for obtaining clearance from local bodies / state Government for installation of mobile towers.

Fax: 033-2324-2147 Website: www.nkdamar.org (b) The other one was issued by Department of Municipal Affairs, Government of West Bengal by letter no. 406/MA/O/C-4/3R-9/2002 dated 4th September, 2013 where the permission for installation of Telecom Towers was treated as sanction of building plan for Telecom Towers and the Urban Local Bodies were empowered to Charge onetime fee (Rs.1.20 lakh in Kolkata Metropolitan Area and Rs.0.75 lakh in other areas) for such sanction.

Since in New Town, Kolkata, there is no urban local body and hence New town Kolkata Development Authority was created for the purpose of providing the civic services which are usually provided by Urban Local Bodies, these guidelines to be made applicable *mutatis mutandis* for this authority and based on these guideline, the following policy is framed.

The Policy of NKDA for Installation of Telecom Towers:

Application for installation of mobile towers shall be submitted by the Telecom Service Provider / Infrastructure Provider to NKDA and to be accompanied by following documents (Self attested).

1. Copy of relevant license / Infrastructure provider Registration Certificate issued by Department of Telecommunications, Government of India.	
2. Data sheet:	In the specified Format Annexure-A
3. Copy of SACFA (Standing Advisory Committee on Radio Frequency Allocation) clearance / copy of SACFA application for the said location submitted to WPC wing of DoT with registration number as WPC acknowledgement along with undertaking in case of any objection / rejection, TSPs / TPs will remove the tower.	
4. Self declaration on radiation: Acknowledgement receipt issued by TERM (Telecom Enforcement, Resource and Monitoring) Cells (DoT) of the self certificate submitted by Telecom Service Provider / Infrastructure Provider in respect of mobile tower / BTS (ground based / roof top / pole / wall mounted) in the format as prescribed by TEC, DoT, establishing / certifying that all general public areas around the tower will be within safe EMR exposure limit as per peak traffic measurement after the antennae start radiating.	
5. Structural Stability Certificate: Ground Based Tower: Copy of structural stability certificate from any authorized / enlisted structural engineer of state / NKDA/ Central Building Research Institute (CBRI), IIT / NIT / Jadavpur University / BESU, Shibpur Roof Top Towers: Copy of structural stability certificate for the building and tower from any authorized / enlisted structural engineer of state / NKDA/ Central Building Research Institute (CBRI), IIT / NIT Jadavpur University / BESU, Shibpur	
6. DG Set Test certificate: Copy of the type test certificate issued by Automotive Research Association of India (ARAI) to the manufacturers of the Diesel Generator (DG) sets.	If DG sets will not be used then a self declaration to that effect in specified format – Annexure-B
7. Clearance from fire safety Department: Copy of clearance from Fire Safety Department in case of Roof Top Towers on High Rise buildings where Fire Clearance is mandatory for such buildings.	If the building does not fall in this category then a self declaration to that effect in

8. Clearance from Forest Department:	Since there is no such area
For Forest protected areas, the copy of clearance from State Environment and Forest Department.	in New Town, Kolkata, this is not required.
9. Land / Roof Top Permission:	
In case of ground based towers:	
Necessary document related to ownership of the land, if the land is not owned by the service provider / infrastructure provider, document related to authorization / NOC from the land owner for erection of Telecom Tower along with his ownership document. In case of roof top towers: (i) No Objection Certificate from the building owner / entities / tenants having roof top rights. (ii) In case of Co-operative Housing Societies, no objection from all members of the society / Chairman and secretary of the society. (iii) In case of housing complexes, no objection from president/secretary of the residents association / no objection from 75% of the flat	
owners. (This has not been mentioned in the guidelines)	
10. Clearance from Airport Authority of India: Though both guidelines are silent on this issue, considering the proximity of	
airport, it is proposed that, if the proposed tower heights are within the	
permissible limit as issued / will be issued by Air Port Authority of India (AAI) /	
by mentioning plot / in zone maps then no separate permission from AAI will need to be submitted to NKDA.	
11. One time fee: Rs.1.20 lakh (subject to such enhancement as will be	
made by the Government of West Bengal)
